



Lunenburg Lit Festival COVID- 19 Protocols

The Lunenburg Lit Festival is an annual Celebration of storytelling hosted by South Shore Public Libraries in Lunenburg, Nova Scotia.

This document has been prepared to comply with public health measures contained in the Nova Scotia Health Protection Order.

South Shore Public Libraries will host the Lunenburg Lit Festival using the following protocol:

- Every person attending the Festival will be required to wear a mask. If they do not have one, a mask will be provided. During the performance, audience members will be permitted to lower their masks for comfort should they wish to do so; masks must be worn at all other times including during any intermissions and following the performance until they leave the facility.
 - The seating in the venue will be arranged in such a way as to ensure any physical distancing requirements can be kept.
 - Only one bathroom will be available for public use during the performance.
 - There will be a distance of 4 metres (12 feet) between the presenter and the first row of audience members.
 - Contact information for contact tracing purposes and may be collected.
 - Guests, volunteers and staff will also be asked if they are feeling well the day of the event and will not be admitted if they identify unwell.
 - All Festival venues will be cleaned before and after each event.
 - All shared items such as the podium and microphones will be disinfected between presenters.
 - Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the venue.
 - Self-screening, Physical distancing, Handwashing and Hand Sanitizer posters will be posted throughout the venue.
 - Lines will be formed for book purchase, book signing, merchandise, etc. and will be monitored for correct social distancing by Festival staff.
